APPLICATION FOR ASSESSED DISCLOSURE - RTI 67/19

I am writing in response to your application for assessed disclosure, dated 14 March 2019, where you seek information in relation to '*Use of Force*' reports recorded by Tasmania Police. The information you seek specifically relates to:

- Statistics on the use of force as recorded in electronic form in Tasmania Police's systems;
- Information in an aggregated format (such as comma delimited format or a Microsoft Excel dataset) for a period of five years; and
- Any data which may accompany the information including (but not limited to) the LAC, location, circumstances, attending officer, time, type of offence etc.

As per our conversation of 1 April 2019, and subsequent email of the same date, you agreed to refine the scope of your application to:

- Include only those reports which were made after the new system came into effect in 2016; and
- To have the names of the attending officers removed.

In assessing the information for disclosure, I am exercising powers delegated to me by the Principal Officer of the Department of Police, Fire and Emergency Management (DPFEM) under Section 21 and 24 of the *Right to Information Act 2009* (Tas) (the Act).

Enquiries and searches of the Department of Police, Fire and Emergency Management (DPFEM) information systems has located information relevant to your request.
